

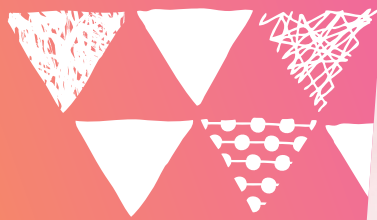

CHC30113 CERTIFICATE III IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION & CARE

This qualification reflects the role expectation of Educators in a range of early childhood education settings including Long Day Care, School Aged Care, Family Day Care and Kindergartens who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. At this entry level Educators facilitate play, and support the social, emotional, physical and educational development of infants and young children.

The responsibilities in this role type are diverse in nature but generally include duties such as the implementation of service programs, the evaluation and assessment of client needs, and coordinating referral processes. Typically these roles provide direct support to individuals or groups of individuals.

You may also have responsibility for the supervision of other workers and volunteers, case management, program coordination or the development of new business opportunities.
