- Upgrade outdated qualifications
- Attain the CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care
- Meet pre-requisite requirements for the CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

ABOUT RPL

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is a process that assesses your competency—acquired through formal and informal learning—to determine if you meet the requirements for a unit of study.

You can use a variety of documentation to apply for RPL. This includes, but is not limited to:

- records of completed training
- assessment items
- assessment records
- declarations from your employer, and/or
- a copy of your student records provided by ASQA.

RPL recognises the skills and knowledge you've acquired throughout your career, giving value to your practical experience. It acknowledges the time and effort you have invested in developing your expertise. You must be currently working as an early childhood educator.
