NSW Fee Free improves access to training for young people, job seekers, First Nations People, unpaid carers, women undertaking study in non-traditional trades and certain categories of visa holders.

It does this by offering:

• Full and part qualification courses

• Courses at TAFE NSW and other Smart and Skilled contracted training providers, including Adult and Community Education providers

• Enrolments until 31 December 2023.

Who is eligible?

Smart and Skilled provides eligible students with an entitlement to government subsidised training up to and including Certificate III; government funding for higher-level courses (Certificate IV and above) in targeted priority areas.

Under Skills NSW, you may be able to study a fee-free course if you are:

- 15 years old or over
- No longer at school
- Living or working in NSW
- An Australian citizen, permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen.
